- Discussion Topics:
 - O Hamilton County Schools Budget: Dr. Donen gave a brief overview on the state of the budget for Hamilton County Schools. The overview included information about the lack of funding for operational and/or instructional purposes. Two items of note were also emphasized. The first was that the Hamilton County commission has not increased taxes in the past ten years to support schools. In fact, the Hamilton County commission has only cut out money from the school system over this ten-year period. Instead of even keeping up with inflation, the commission has done the opposite by taking money away. The second was that sales tax in the Chattanooga area does not go toward local schools. That money is sent back to the state. The state then allocates money back to each school district in the state based on a formula for determining wealth. Based on this formula, Hamilton County is considered in the top three counties for wealth, and thus, receives one of the lowest state disbursements for education. In essence, the only way to currently fund schools in Hamilton County adequately would be from local property taxes, which is controlled by the Hamilton County commission. If we want to have good and great schools in our county, funding is going to have to change.
